Thank you for your letters regarding the above-captioned matter. Pursuant to the FECA Procedure Manual Part 2, Claims, Section 2-100 FECA Third Part Subrogation Guidelines, "The percentage must be considered reasonable by OWCP or EEWC. Generally, any fee in excess of 40% would be deemed inappropriate and such deduction would be disallowed." As the attorney's fees for services in the above-captioned matter were not in excess of 40%, we contend that the fees charged should be deemed reasonable. As there appears to be no other objection to the Statement of Recovery, I am returning to you our original check in the amount of \$12,432.24 in satisfaction of the refund to the U.S. Department of Labor. Thank you for your prompt response, and fulfillment of the various requirements for Mr is case. We have reviewed the EN-1108 you provided and noticed that there was a discrepancy that has altered the amount to be refunded.

The government allowance for attorney's fees retained by the claimant in line 15 on the long form statement of recovery can only equal 33.3% or one-third of line 14. This leaves the balance on line 16 to be \$13,432.24.
