AWARD OF COMPENSATION

The Office of Workers' Compensation finds that the employee's death is covered under the Federal Employee's Compensation Act (FECA). In accordance with 5 U.S.C. 8133, compensation benefits are approved for the following dependents at the indicated rate.

PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION

The computation of benefits is based on the employee's pay rate, which is determined to be \$3,698.50 per month. All survivor benefits are paid every 28 days.

Social Security death benefits which are attributable to the Federal service of an employee covered under the Federal Employees' Retirement System (FERS) are deducted from FECA benefits because they create a prohibited dual benefit. If a beneficiary, who is not currently in receipt of Social Security benefits later applies for Social Security benefits this office must be advised immediately so that we may coordinate the appropriate adjustment to FECA benefits.

Your initial payment, in the amount of \$29,770.48, covers from 03/13/2018 through 08/17/2019.

Your continuing payments each 28 days will be in the amount of \$1,589.44

If you have a disability and are in need of communication assistance (such as alternate formats or sign language interpretation), accommodation(s) and/or modification(s), please contact OWCP.

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Benefits for a dependent child are paid to the surviving parent or legal guardian. If a parent is also entitled to benefits as a surviving spouse, benefits paid for a dependent child are included in the payment to the spouse.

If you disagree with this decision, you should carefully review the attached appeal rights, and pursue whichever avenue is appropriate to your situation.
